

How to put out your waste and recycling out for collection

- On your property boundary and not in a communal pile
- Bags tied
- Loose items will not be collected
- Cardboard must go into the recycling sack
- If a bag, bin or box is contaminated it will not be collected or emptied
- Please put your house number on your bins and boxes
- Good quality clothing, shoes and textiles can be taken to charity shops

Put your waste out for collection between

5pm and 7am

the day before on your collection day

And NO earlier

Green Bin



all food waste



garden waste

Yellow Battery Bag



all batteries (that fit in the bag)

Leave batteries for collection in the yellow bag on top of your green bin and a replacement bag will be left for you.



Blue Box



unbroken glass bottles & jars

Unbroken glass bottles & jars with lids removed – it is important that you take off the metal lids of jars or metal screw tops of bottles and put them in your clear recycling sack.



Black Sack



polystyrene



poor quality textiles*



plastic bags



broken glass & china wrapped up



animal waste & bedding



nappies & sanitary products



plastic film, crisp & sweet wrappers
