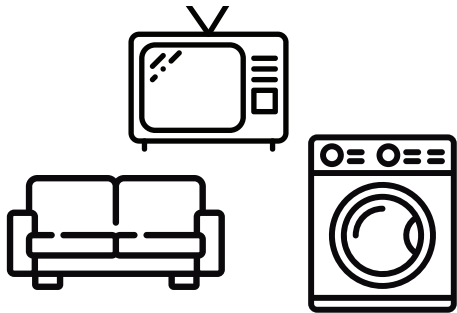


There are three sites in Milton Keynes where you can recycle household waste items.

# How to put out your waste and recycling out for collection

- On your property boundary and not in a communal pile
- Bags tied
- Loose items will not be collected
- Cardboard must go into the recycling sack
- If a bag, bin or box is contaminated it will not be collected or emptied
- Please put your house number on your bins and boxes

\* Good quality clothing, shoes and textiles can be taken to charity shops

Put your waste out for collection between

**5pm and 7am**

the day before on your collection day

**And NO earlier**

## Clear Recycling Sack

	<b>food tins &amp; drink cans</b>
	<b>mixed paper &amp; envelopes</b>
	<b>plastic bottles (no lids) and food packaging</b>
	<b>empty aerosols</b>
	<b>cardboard</b>
	<b>clean foil trays</b>
	<b>Juice and milk cartons</b>

## Green Bin

	<b>all food waste</b>
	<b>garden waste</b>

## Yellow Battery Bag



**all batteries (that fit in the bag)**

Leave batteries for collection in the yellow bag on top of your green bin and a replacement bag will be left for you.



## Blue Box



**unbroken glass bottles & jars**

Unbroken glass bottles & jars with lids removed – it is important that you take off the metal lids of jars or metal screw tops of bottles and put them in your clear recycling sack.



## Black Sack

	<b>polystyrene</b>
	<b>poor quality textiles*</b>
	<b>plastic bags</b>
	<b>broken glass &amp; china wrapped up</b>
	<b>animal waste &amp; bedding</b>
	<b>nappies &amp; sanitary products</b>
	<b>plastic film, crisp &amp; sweet wrappers</b>
